- 2. Hold a 2023 Nova Scotia Cattle Grower License and have 2022 and 2021 levies paid in full by the application deadline.
- 3. Agree to provide copies of soil, manure and/or feed analysis as part of the application.
- 4. Agree to abide by the current NSCP Soil, Pasture and Forage Management Program Guidelines.
- \*\*Eligible costs are only applicable for the 2023 year.

Applications may be submitted at any time, however, will only be processed at the June 30, 2023 and November 30, 2023 application deadlines.
