Additional funding has been received for Elite Sire Purchases! Through the NSDA we have secured additional funding for the purchase of bulls under our Elite Sire Program. Funding will still be available at 30% of the purchase price but now to a maximum of \$1,300 and the \$100 bonus for proof of negative RFI will remain with an overall program maximum of \$5,000. This funding will be available through the end of the 2024 program year. Applications received by the June 30th, 2023, deadline will be reevaluated at the new limits and additional payments will be automatically issued. ON-FARM CATTLE PRECONDITIONING

We continue to offer pre-conditioning services to producers through our *On-Farm Cattle Preconditioning*. This project aims to improve cattle herd health in the province by increasing the quantity and quality of vaccinated brood cows and preconditioned feeder calves. Specifically, the project will focus on recruiting farms identified through previous projects which do not currently have an on-farm preconditioning program. The project will also recruit farms that want to enhance their preconditioning program by adding specified practices.


Producers will be able to book any combination of available onfarm services through the NSCP office. Our pre-conditioning services include:

- Handling equipment and help
- Tagging
- Age verification
- Vaccination administration
- Castration
- Dehorning
- Weighing

For producers to participate in these on-farm services, they must:

- participate in workshops and training,
- have a valid Veterinary-Client-Patient-Relationship (VCPR),
- participate in the Herd Health Program
- have a valid Premise Identification (PID)
- complete age verification
- be in good standing with the Nova Scotia Cattle Producers

Services will be performed by technician Scott Dixon and his team at the Atlantic Stockyards Ltd. The NSCP office will coordinate farms by geography to reduce costs and travel redundancy. The cost structure for this service will be the same as the carcass ultrasound.
