Junior Incentive Purchase Program.....

Any junior who purchases at the 2012 Autumn Classic Sale and registers the animal in their name will receive a 10% discount off the total purchase price at the time of payment. To be eligible junior members must be 21 years of age or younger, in conjunction with the Canadian Shorthorn Association, and reside in a Maritime province.



Terms & Conditions.....

TIME – Saturday October 20, 2012 following the Hereford and Angus sales beginning at 12:30pm.

TERMS OF SALE - Are cash (cheques accepted) unless previous arrangements are made with owner. Owner has one protective bid.

GUARENTEE – We hereby guarantee that subject to proper treatment, care and exercise, all animals are warranted to be breeders. In the event of an animal proving to be a non-breeder, after receiving proper care and attention, we agree to supply the purchaser with an animal of approximately equal age, quality and breeding, or to refund 90% of the purchase price, providing the purchaser files a protect and proof in writing with us within six months of the date of sale, but we may if we desire, have the animal returned for a retrial for a period not to exceed six months. If the animal proves not to be a breeder then the purchaser receives the substitute or refund as stipulated above.


